About the Project:

Portola Avenue connects residential communities to Highway 111 to the north and Living Desert Zoo and Gardens to the south. During the winter months of November and December, the Living Desert Zoo and Gardens hosts the WildLights event. During this time, the neighborhood sees an increase in visitors on local roads. The City of Palm Desert is looking for community feedback to better understand mobility in this area. This project aims to develop a suite of traffic strategies to address mobility while continuing to welcome visitors to the Living Desert.
